## Shortage of priests

We are aware that the current situation means that things can change very quickly. During the course of the last week it has become clear that Fr. Willoughby of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour, Longshaw, Blackburn, needs residential care. He is a Jesuit priest and the Jesuits have taken him to one of their houses to receive the assessment and care that he needs.

His parish has been handed to the two Darwen parishes to cover with immediate effect. We are not sure what this will mean in practice and whether it will be permanent or short-term, but it is a reminder that we need to be moving to a situation where more parishioners take more responsibility for the life and running of the parish because priests are not always going to be there to do the day to day stuff which keeps parishes going.

This weekend Fr. Dugdale will say the vigil mass at Our Lady's, the 9 a.m. mass at St. Joseph's, the 11 a.m. mass at Sacred Heart and the 5.30 p.m. mass at Sacred Heart. I will say the vigil mass at St. Joseph's, the 10.00 a.m. mass at Our Lady's and the noon baptisms at St. Joseph's.

There will be a meeting during the week with the Dean to discuss future cover for Sundays, weekdays, funerals, baptisms, weddings, sacramental programme, etc. There is going to have to be flexibility of mass times and an over-all reduction in masses, Sundays and weekdays. No decisions will be finalised without consultation, but clearly it is not going to be possible to keep everyone happy. Your patience and generosity of spirit will be needed.

Please keep Fr. Willoughby and our three parishes in your prayers.
